A horse, regardless of its training and usual past behavior, may act unpredictably at times based upon instinct or fright which may cause you to be thrown from your horse or injured. Horses do such things as bite, kick, buck, lie down, stumble, and any number of other activities which may pose a possible risk. Saddles may slip and other tack or saddle problems may develop as a result of normal use and wear. Your horse may collide with obstacles or encounter variations in terrain such as creeks, water, bridges, traveled roads, wild animals, birds, stumps, forest growth, debris, rocks, and cliffs. As well as other obstacles, whether obvious or not, and whether man made or natural. Each of those obstacles or variations in terrain could cause you to lose control of your horse and you could fall. Riding a horse requires the participant to balance on the saddle. One may lose their balance that can result in falling off the horse.

Furthermore, IWR guides have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are fallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities. They might misjudge the weather, the elements, or the terrain. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction.
